Lori Hager, from Assured Partners, presented the Board with options for the township's medical insurance plans for 2020. The options were discussed in depth.

The owners of 385 Marcus Avenue received their letter and will comply.

A letter was sent to the owner of 4230 Flowers Road informing them that the house will need to be demolished.

Mr. Gleisinger updated the Board on the Road Department. Oberlanders Tree and Landscape will be working on the tree list that was approved in June.

The Board discussed the properties of 2116 Frey Road and 290 Rudy Road.

The jake brake signs have been delivered to the state.

Mr. Gleisinger updated the Board on the Revenue Sharing Agreement. The township is getting approximately \$3,500 a year.

Motion #191-19: Mr Currens moved to increase Chief Carey's salary by \$2,500 effective November 23, 2019, seconded by Mr. Orewiler and upon a roll call vote all members voted "AYE".

Motion #192-19: Mr. Currens moved to approve the Ohio Plan Liability Policy as presented to us by Mark Pfizenmayer, from Ohio Plan Risk Management, Inc, at the last meeting, seconded by Mr. Orewiler and upon a roll call vote all members voted "AYE".

Mr. Currens updated the Board on the Richland County Regional Planning Committee full commission meeting he attended on October 23rd.

A guard rail on Walker Lake Road has been damaged by a hit and skip. The county came and placed some safety barriers until it can be fixed.

Mr. Currens received a complaint call from a Lohr Road resident upset about a neighbors' dogs constantly barking. Him informed them that it is a civil matter but advised him to write a letter to his neighbor.
