Trustee Gleisinger informed everyone that the Springfield Township Historical Society will be meeting the 2nd Wednesday of every month in the Township Hall at 6pm.

Chief Carey presented the Board with an updated fee schedule for them to review.

Chief Carey informed the Board that he has collected some data and is working on getting them the information and would like to start being able to give them monthly reports instead of quarterly.

EMS billing issues was discussed.

New E-21 still has some work to be done to it before it can go into service.

Motion #03-20: Trustee Orewiler moved to deem the old air packs are no longer able to be used and allow Chief Carey to donate them, seconded by Trustee Rose and upon a roll call vote all members voted "AYE".

The Fire Department budget was discussed. Chief is working on compiling a list of some projects he will be working on.

Ralph Beer is moving and won't be able to be on the Zoning Board. There will be an opening for the Zoning Board.

Trustee Orewiler updated the Board on the 290 Rudy Road property. The property owner has been given another week to get the property cleaned up. He has a 2nd hearing tomorrow.

The Board discussed the new cell tower on Cookton-Grange Road. The company took it to court and got the tower approved. A driveway is being put in now. Some residents are not happy. They weren't aware that it was approved.

Trustee Gleisinger updated The Board on the Road Department. They fixed some signs on Alta West and have been cleaning up dead trees.

A property at 2025 Tulipwood Drive has been having flooding issues. Trustee Gleisinger has been looking into it to see if there is anything the township can do. The problems are on private property. The tile near the catch basin is flowing good.

Trustee Gleisinger has a quote for 2 man doors at the Road Department from J&B Acoustical for \$2,469. The quote will be reviewed and discussed at the next meeting.

Motion #04-20: Trustee Gleisinger moved to accept the amended change to the 2020 Temporary Appropriations, seconded by Trustee Orewiler and upon a roll call vote all members voted "AYE".

The Board signed the December Management reports.

Public Comment:

Craig Hunt asked if there were any doors stored in the garage that could be used at the Road Department. Chief Carey will look in the garage to see if there are any. He also asked if there has been a Native American sitting at the site of the cell tower while it's being built. He has been to the property to check and make sure the site is not part of an Indian burial site.

Motion #05-20: There being no further business to come before the Board, Trustee Gleisinger made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Trustee Orewiler motion carried.

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The meeting adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
