Trustee Orewiler had some questions regarding Careworks and a BWC claim. Is our attorney needed at the next court date? The Board agreed that he wasn't needed.

Trustee Gleisinger updated the Board on the road department. They have been busy picking up leaves and picking up debrief from some bad storms.

Township limit signs have been put up.

Trustee Gleisinger updated the Board with some changes to the Road Department job description.

Dave Siebold's Zoning Board term is up this year and he has agreed to be renewed. A motion will be made at our end of year meeting in December to make a motion renewing his term. Steve Santmeyer will not be renewing his term on the Appeals Board.

Motion #180-20: Trustee Gleisinger made a motion to waive the health insurance premium percentage paid by the employees for the month of

December as a premium holiday due to the township receiving a discounted premium for the month by MedMutual, seconded by Trustee Orewiler and upon a roll call vote all members voted "AYE".

Motion #181-20: Trustee Gleisinger made a motion to go into Executive Session at 7:44 pm to discuss personnel issues. Trustee Orewiler seconded the motion and upon a roll call all members voted "AYE".

Motion #182-20: Trustee Gleisinger moved to return to regular session at 8:09 pm, Mr. Orewiler seconded and upon a roll call all members voted "AYE".

Motion #183-20: Trustee Gleisinger moved to accept the request from Road Foreman, Sam Kleilein, to step down to the position of Road Laborer, decreasing his pay to \$24.00 an hour. Also, to promote Charlie Kleilein from the Road Laborer position to the Road Foreman, at an increase of pay to \$24.00 an hour and an increase in pay after six months of \$0.50 an hour with a probationary period of 1-year. After the one-year probationary period, the position would increase an additional \$0.50 for the Road Foreman. Both positions will be entitled to cost of living raises as decided by the Springfield Board of Trustees in 2022. They will forgo the cost of living raise in the year 2021. The effective date for these changes will be December 19, 2020, seconded by Trustee Orewiler and upon a roll call vote all members voted "AYE".

Motion #184-20: There being no further business to come before the Board, Trustee Orewiler made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Trustee Gleisinger motion carried.
