Chief updated the Board on some maintenance issues with the vehicles. One medic needs tires and the other needs a turbo. L-23 is still being worked on and awaiting parts.

The Board discussed the purchase of 8-tactical bulletproof vests. They agreed to wait until the new year to consider purchasing.

Asst. Chief Spellman and Lt. Meredith are researching options for the purchase of a new squad. The Board discussed a few options of different companies to use.
