Public was given a phone number to call in to have access and participate in the meeting remotely.

Due to a longer meeting tonight, Trustee Gleisinger has suspended public comment. Trustee Rose does not think it's right to suspend public comment since there are so many people at the meeting tonight and should have the right to speak. Trustee Gleisinger went on to say that the union is not recognized. They should follow the chain of command to report issues instead of talking about them during public comment. The firefighters can call the trustees on their cell phones to express their concerns at any time. He does not want the board meeting to turn into a circus this evening and there are some outside things being stirred. Being the Chairman, Trustee Gleisinger made the final decision to suspend all public comment for tonight's meeting.

Chief Carey updated the Board on the RTF training at the high/middle school last week.

As of now, the township will not be receiving any more Rescue Plan funding.

Trustee Rose would like to add to the agenda a motion to rescind the covid restrictions.

Motion #118-21: Trustee Rose made a motion to rescind the covid restriction limiting the amount of people allowed in the township's public meetings. Motion died due to lack of 2nd motion.

Trustee Orewiler updated the Board on the roof at St#2. The roof has been completed and looks great.

One of the air conditioners at St#2 is not working. A new one has been ordered.

Trustee Orewiler has been receiving complaints regarding plants being taken from grave sites at the township cemeteries. It was also discussed how often the cemeteries are being mowed as well as overall cemetery rules.

Trustee Gleisinger updated the Board on the road department. They have been mowing a lot and placing tile at Wiles Estates.

Trustee Gleisinger has also been receiving complaints about 276 Creston Drive where a bunch of dirt is being piled up at the back of the property. Someone is building a pond or maybe a house. A letter has been sent to the property owner to find out what is going on and if the proper channels are being taken. Richland County Soil and Water is looking into it.

There is nothing that needs to be done with the Township's Equipment Levy this year.

The Board signed the May Management reports.

Trustee Rose asked if ESO Solutions has received their check. A new check with the correct address has been issued and mailed.

June 18th is the deadline to make reservations for the RCTA Picnic.

FO Kochheiser updated the Board on the Sedgwick BWC Group Retrospective Rating agreement for 2022.

Motion #119-21: Trustee Gleisinger made a motion to renew our participation in the 2022 Group Retrospective Rating Program with Sedgwick BWC Group. Trustee Orewiler seconded the motion and upon a roll call all members voted "AYE".

The township has received their first payment from Sandusky Township.


