I/C Spellman updated the Board regarding the sale of the ladder truck. Dayton is no longer interested in our truck as they had concerns with some rust on the frame. It has been close to 4 months since we listed the truck and he asked if we should consider lowering the price. The Board would like to wait until this is done.

He also asked about the potential new ambulance purchase again. Prices will continue to rise, and it will take a couple years to get one once ordered. He would like to use leftover ARPA money towards this and would like to get a spot in line.

## **Public Comment:**

Gino Mollica – lives caddy corner from Station #2. He received a certified letter while on vacation regarding the Verizon Cell Tower construction. The letter was dated September 26, 2023 and they only have 15 days to respond. He wants to know why the rush on the amount of time from the receipt of the letter and he also expressed his safety concerns with having this tower in a residential area and doesn't think it's a good idea for the township.

Melanie Bogantz also was in attendance, and she lives as close to Station #2 as Mr. Mollica, but she did not receive a certified letter. The Trustees explained the process of sending a letter to the Zoning Board, and Trustee Gleisinger will contact Michael Sarris from Verizon.
