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Motion #102-2023: Trustee Carns made a motion to approve the donation of 48 hrs. of sick time from Joshua Bradley to an employee in need in the fire department, seconded by Trustee Gleisinger, and upon a roll call vote, all members voted "AYE."

Trustee Daugherty spoke with all the bidders for the St#2 air conditioning quotes and did a comparison for the Board to review. There were 4 bids for AC only and 3 for replacing both the heat & AC, with 2 bidders quoting Armstrong units and 2 bidders quoting Trane units. He feels the Trane unit is more for commercials and has a longer warranty as well. The Board agrees to replace the furnace and AC.

Motion #103-2023: Trustee Daugherty made a motion to award the bid for the replacement of the AC and furnace at Station #2 at the cost of \$10,039.00 to Buckeye Horizon, as well as also award them the bid for the second furnace at station #2 at the cost of \$4,339.00 seconded by Trustee Gleisinger and upon a roll call vote all members voted "AYE."

Trustee Daugherty feels that we need to make a decision regarding Fire Department staffing requirements as Chief Carey brought on a 6th man as minimum manning; however, he was unable to find anything in the minutes approving that. The mandated 6th man is causing a lot of overtime and confusion and is being filled with full-timers by some of the schedulers, causing a lot of overtime and mandates.

Motion #104-2023: Trustee Daugherty made a motion to clarify our scheduling to be a minimum manning of 5 with the scheduling of a 6th person filled with a part-timer not to be mandated, seconded by Trustee Carns, and upon a roll call vote, all members voted "AYE."

Trustee Daugherty has been working on design pricing for St#1 roof replacement and parking lot repairs but has not received any pricing yet.

Trustee Gleisinger informed the Board that the road department received quotes for tree removals on Eckstein and Springmill for dead tree removal.

Motion #105-2023: Trustee Gleisinger made a motion to hire Oberlander's Tree Service at the cost of \$2,500 to remove 5 dead trees on Eckstein & Springmill Roads, seconded Trustee Carns and upon a roll call vote, all members voted "AYE."

Resolution #106-2023: Trustee Gleisinger moved to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with Madison Township to resurface Home Road from Deer Park North to the intersection of Marion Avenue at the cost of \$65,000.00 with the split being Madison Township at 30% or \$19,500, Springfield Township at 70% or \$45,500, seconded by Trustee Daugherty and upon a roll call voted all members voted "AYE."

Trustee Gleisinger received a complaint from a resident on Villa Drive and Scott Drive about the fire hydrants on those roads not being flushed due to it being private. FF Gray made a call and stated that we do flush them and bill the HOA. Trustee Gleisinger will inform the resident of this.

The MS4 is doing dry weather monitoring, and residents may see green dye in waterways. The road crew is working on getting roads ready for chip and seal as well as mowing and spraying.

FO Kochheiser presented the June Management reports for the Boards approval, and the same were signed and approved.

Public Comment:

FF Dustin Gray stated that Crestline Fire Department has virtually no fire departments left, and they have taken Springfield off their list for mutual aid.
