Brian Butcher summarized tasks he was given by the Trustees. They are as follows:

- Make package comparable to other departments
- Save money
- Address burnout

#### Below is a summary of changes:

- Vacation taken in increments of 8 hours instead of 24 hours
- Juneteenth
- 2756 hours at an hourly rate (take salary divided by 2496 then pay that rate for the 2756 rate)
- Comp time cap on 240 accrued hours/anything over 120 at end of October gets paid out
  - 120 carries over and will be available in addition to the
    240 accrued the following year
- Maternity/parental leave were updated to be consistent with the law
- Transitional/light duty eliminated for non-work related injuries
- Don looking into short-term disability
- Military Leave updated
- Longevity will be added to hourly rate and added 20 years at \$1,000 (\$.36)
- 14-day work period 106 hours before OT starts
