The Road Department has been busy salting and plowing. Also, a house at 579 Rudy Road had a sinkhole in the middle of the driveway. The Road Department bought new tile and replaced the tile in the driveway.

There was a complaint from a resident on Christmore St. about his driveway not being plowed. Springfield Township can only plow the first 230 feet which is just shy of the complainant's driveway. Beyond this is private property owned by the complainant's neighbor and the neighboring property owner does not want Springfield Township to plow his property.

Trustee Gleisinger updated the Board of the 2025 Road Mileage Certification from ODOT which remained unchanged, and the Board approved same.



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Trustee Gleisinger received communication from Mark Romanchuck, Marilyn John, and Tony Vero over the Oil Well on Burnison Road in response to a letter written by Dr. Gregory Timberlake. The resident of Burnison Road, Gregory Timberlake, complained to the Township about the noise and fumes coming from the well. The Township has nothing to do with the permits for the well and can't do anything about the well. The ODNR (Ohio Department of Natural Resources) handles the permits, regulations, and types of wells allowed.

Trustee Orewiler updated the Board on the water bill from Ontario City. The Mayor of Ontario needs to reply to Trustee Orewiler with a meeting date to discuss.

Fiscal Officer Kochheiser presented the December Management Reports to the trustees for approval. Board approved.
