- Never dump anything down a storm drain.
- Always pick up after your pet. Pet waste carries bacteria that could wash into our rivers, streams and water supply.
- When you mow your lawn, keep grass clippings out of the street and driveways. Not only do they clog the storm drains, but the pesticides and fertilizers we use on our lawns find their way into the water we drink, swim in and the fish we eat.
